## **MS2933 Developing Business Process and Integration Solutions Using BizTalk Server 2006/2009**

Configuring common adapters to enable BizTalk integration. Creating an orchestration to represent a business process. Using orchestration shapes to define a detailed business process. Configuring an orchestration for transactional business processing. Creating, deploying, and managing a BizTalk application. Configuring BizTalk to consume and publish Web services. Configuring business rules and call a business rule from within an orchestration. Enabling Business Activity Monitoring (BAM) functions for business users. Integrating trading partners into a business process.

Topics: Advanced Schemas. Advanced Mappings. Implementing Rules with the Rule Manager. Using Endpoints. Consuming and Building Web Services. Convoys and Correlation Sets. Integration Patterns. Deployment Strategies.
